

For this assignment, you will work in a small group to create a poem in the style of the Japanese Haiku tradition. This poem will then be arranged and performed using your choice of classroom instruments. This assignment is worth 10 points.

While traditional Haiku is characterized by a naturalistic theme and and a seasonal setting, your Haiku poem will be inspired by a particular color. You will, however, need to adhere to its characteristic 17-syllable structure where the first and last lines are each five syllables and the intervening line contains seven syllables. There is no need to rhyme.
